Job Summary:

The Arkansas Game and Fish (AGFC) Fleet Manager is responsible for the management and maintenance of a 700-vehicle fleet. This role is responsible for ensuring the efficiency, safety, and cost-effectiveness of the fleet by utilizing a technology-based fleet management system. The Fleet Manager will coordinate vehicle acquisition, routine maintenance, and compliance with regulatory requirements. Additionally, the Fleet Manager will supervise staff, analyze fleet performance metrics, and implement strategies to optimize fleet operations.

Typical Functions:

- Oversee the daily operations of the state agency's fleet, ensuring all vehicles are operating safely and efficiently.
- Utilize the fleet management system to track vehicle locations, maintenance schedules, fuel consumption, and driver performance.
- Manage the procurement, leasing, and disposal of fleet vehicles according to the agency's needs and policies.
- Schedule and oversee routine maintenance, repairs, and inspections to minimize downtime and prolong the life of the vehicles.
- Ensure the fleet complies with federal, state, and local regulations, including safety and environmental standards.
- Prepares and submits Department of Transportation (DOT) compliance reports, and establishes and maintains internal and external vendor relationships.
- Develop and manage the fleet budget, identifying cost-saving opportunities and monitoring expenditures related to fuel, repairs, and replacements.
