The Arkansas Game and Fish Commission (AGFC) Education Statewide Coordinator is responsible for managing, training, and coordinating the activities of program sponsors for various educational programs. This position is governed by state and federal laws and agency policy

Typical Functions:

Develops, monitors, and conducts education and programs designed to train volunteers and program sponsors for various educational programs

Develops and oversees annual budgets for programs within the assigned region.

Participates in the presentation of special interest seminars

Responsible for obtaining instructional materials for program activities and their sponsors

Writes and reviews information designed to communicate to the public through programs, media, and other communication outlets concerning educational programs and regulatory requirements.

Provides technical assistance with the design and development of educational training aids and materials.

Designs, develops, and maintains exhibits and information booths at special events and activities such as school career day activities and fairs.

Performs special research projects and provides technical information and assistance to various colleges, high schools, and the general public.

Visits community leaders and school administrators to evaluate the implementation and effectiveness of the various programs.

May supervise a professional and administrative support staff by interviewing applicants, making hire or termination recommendations, training, assigning and reviewing work, and evaluating the performance of incumbents.

Performs other duties as assigned.

Specific Duties and Responsibilities:

- Manage and coordinate statewide programs for Hunter Education and Boating Education
- Work with volunteer instructors statewide in both programs, supporting them with training, materials, scheduling, etc.
- Work with federal aid
